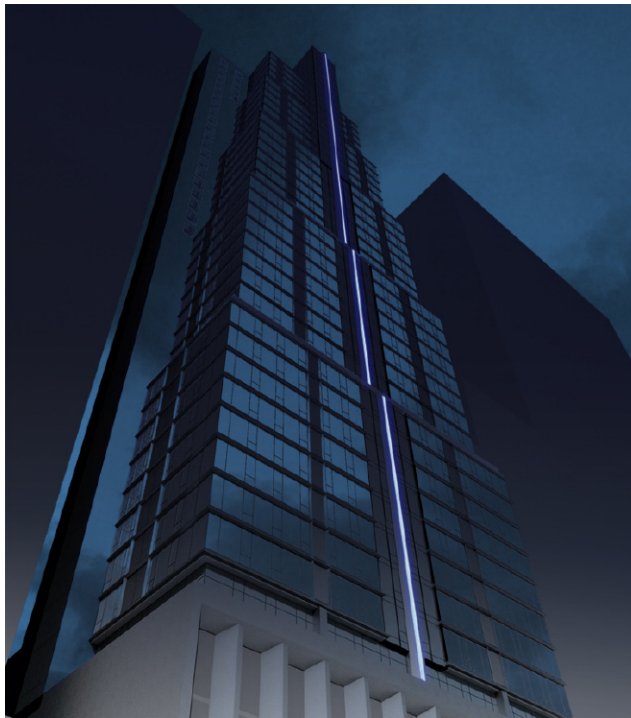


“ 52nd lamp ” / Wall lamp



I was commissioned to create and design a permanent light art installation on the facade of the 52nd Street building by the owner and developer who transform this hotel in private luxury apartments and offices. A vertical light stripe as a vein in the centre of the building, settled from its top to almost bottom, will softly light its surroundings, each night. A warm and peaceful light will appear and disappear as if the building was breathing, in a quiet mood, opposite of the urban restless rhythm. Inspired from this installation and the architectural shape of the building, we have imagined a wall-lamp refining the lines & shapes and replacing glass with onyx or white marble. Especially designed for these Luxury flats, the Element of Light, called “52th”, plays with the translucence of the “crystal” luxurious stones.
